Open to adults, 16 and older with Nebraska fishing permits (<https://ngpc-home.ne.gov/ps/faces/index.xhtml>) and youth up to 15 years of age.



- Youth must be accompanied by an adult.
- Fishing from boat, shoreline, or kayak permitted.
- No live bait permitted (state regulation).
- Night crawlers or frozen minnows are recommended.
- Admission to Wildwood Lake is free and no entry permit is required.
- Enjoy parking, boat ramp, no wake boating, restrooms. (<https://www.lpsnrd.org/wildwood-lake>)

There is no rain date for this event. Check the Seward Area Lutherans for Life Facebook page for cancellation or a delayed start. In the event of a cancellation the entry fees will not be refunded. If a cancellation occurs, please pick up your T-Shirt at the St. John Fellowship Hall on Saturday, May 18 or call 402-617-3410 to make other arrangements.

All participants will receive a T-Shirt, Free Lunch, and rent-free fishing pole use for youth, if needed.

Winners will be determined by the longest total length of 3 fish (any combination of Crappie and Blue Gill). Winner categories: Adults, Teenagers, and Youth. Winners will receive a trophy.
