

# Welcome to St. John Lutheran School!

We are excited to have you join our family, where we provide a strong, Christ-centered education and everyone is known by name. The projected cost per pupil for the 2022 – 2023 school year at St. John Lutheran School in Kindergarten through 8th Grade is \$7050. In order to be good stewards of our limited resources within our congregational budget, we ask families to select a tuition option that is financially feasible as we continue to provide an excellent Christ-centered education.



**This option covers the cost of your child's education in full without congregational assistance.**

**Half-day Kindergarten:  
\$5250**

**Full-day K – Grade 8:  
\$7050**



**This option covers approximately 50% of the cost of your child's education with 50% provided from congregational assistance.**

**Half-day Kindergarten:  
\$2775**

**Full-day K – Grade 8:  
\$3700**



**This option covers 35% of the cost of your child's education and is available to families in need of substantial congregational assistance of 65% or *\*more*.**

**Half-day Kindergarten:  
\$1870**

**Full-day K – Grade 8:  
\$2700**

### **OPTION C MULTIPLE CHILD RATES:**

Second child: \$2000; Third child: \$1500; Fourth child: \$625.

### **APPLICATION/RE-ENROLLMENT FEE:**

\$50 per student (nonrefundable). For re-enrolling students, this fee is applied to the first tuition payment for 2022 – 23.

### **PAYMENT OPTIONS:**

- Full year payment: Due prior to the first day of school in August.
- Monthly deduction from a bank account at no charge to the family.
- Forms are available from the school office.
- The account must be paid in full prior to the last day of school in May 2023.
- Payment plan and payments may begin immediately after the initial enrollment or re-enrollment is completed.

### **\*FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:**

**The congregation of St. John Lutheran Church is committed to the support of the school such that no family will be prevented from sending their child to St. John Lutheran School due to financial concerns. Families that need assistance beyond Option C can formally apply for financial aid through the school office.**
