The Nebraska Walk For Life will begin at the north steps of the State Capitol in Lincoln, 14th & K Street, at 10 a.m. on **Saturday, January 16**. From there the walk is to the Newman Center, 320 No. 16th Street (16th & Q), where the Keynote Speaker, Sarah Zagorski, will talk at noon.

Born at 26.5 weeks gestation, Sarah's story is one of survival, hope and healing. As one of 11 siblings living in extreme poverty, she was sexually abused by a family member. She was adopted at age 9 by a loving family after spending 7 1/2 years in Louisiana's foster care system.

Sarah understands what a gift life is and how hard it can be. She loves to share her story and her passion for life with her audiences.
